Prezi in your teaching

Prezi is a free, flash-based tool which acts like a big digital wall where you can post text, graphic, pictures and video to visualize complex subjects. By using Prezi's zoom effect you can make your own small stories.



Different uses of Prezi in your teaching

Prezi is primarily used as a presentation tool by teachers and students. Prezi is especially useful for presentations of non-linear, abstract or complex subjects, like mindmaps, concept maps, project charts or flow charts, but can also be used as:

- A visual work table/thinking board; when thinking of and working with relations between objects (mind-maps, concept maps)
- A portfolio tool for visualization of learning processes
- A collaboration tool; as up to 10 people can work at the same prezi at the same time

Prezi for group presentations in psychology

Bachelor students in Psychology module 2 have to deliver three group assignments during the first three weeks of their group lectures. Every week one group makes a 10 minutes oral presentation of their finished reports.

The purpose of using Prezi in the group lectures has been to introduce students to a new and alternative presentation tool instead of PowerPoint as Prezi is considered useful for students in their future education and when they enter the job market.

Inspirational Prezi presentations were shown to the students and Student Assistant, Didde Fuglsang-Jensen attended a CUU-Prezi-course so that she was able to make an [introductory video for the students](#).
